The European Union (EU) recently began enforcing its General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The GDPR applies to any entity—whether established in the EU or not—that processes the personal data of EU subjects when offering them goods or services or monitoring their behavior. These entities must disclose how personal data will be used, how long it will be stored, what safeguards protect it, and how to correct, transfer, and delete such data.

Students interested in cybersecurity, data protection, and privacy issues must be familiar with the GDPR's extraterritorial reach and its enforcement and penalty scheme.

Mauricio F. Paez, a partner in the New York office of Jones Day, will give an overview of the GDPR. For the past three years, he has been recognized in *The Legal 500 US* as one of the leaders in global data protection, privacy, and outsourcing. A recipient of *The National Law Journal*'s 2015 Cybersecurity Trailblazer Award, Mr. Paez received his B.A. and J.D. from Rutgers University, and also a degree from its School of Planning and Public Policy.
